Scott began his career with SD Myers, one of the organizations now stewarded by Good Place Holdings, more than 43 years ago. During his tenure, he served in numerous roles, including field technician, department manager, and ultimately President of SD Myers. Following the formation of Good Place Holdings in 2015, he served as Chairman of the Board for more than nine years.

Although Scott's formal roles evolved over time, his influence never diminished. The culture he helped establish, the values he faithfully protected, and the countless lives he impacted remain woven into the fabric of Good Place Holdings and the many organizations and individuals shaped by his leadership.
